Regulations for Encouraging Outstanding Advisors of the College of Social Sciences

Approved at the 2nd meeting of college affairs in the 2003 academic year, January 08, 2004
Modified and approved at the 3rd meeting of college affairs in the 2004 academic year, January 05, 2004
Modified and approved at the 4th meeting of college affairs in the 2011 academic year, March 27, 2012

1. **Objectives:** The College of Social Sciences (hereinafter referred to as “The College”) establishes these Regulations to reward outstanding advisors, improve their educational functions, promote the spirit of teaching and education, and create a good academic environment in The College.
2. **Funds:** Advanced EMPP Academic Fund.
3. **Application scope:** The Regulations are applicable to the teacher who has acted as an advisor for one year or more, taken full responsibility as an advisor and guided a student with achievements.
4. **Rewarding:** At most two outstanding advisors are selected every year and each of them is awarded one medal and NT\$ 10,000. The **reward** must be used for teaching material, equipment and research. The winners are the representatives of The College for selection of the outstanding advisors at University level.
5. **Selection procedure:** Each department/institute recommends one candidate before the end of February every year. The candidates are subject to the review of The College’s Academic Review Committee.
6. These Regulations are approved at the meeting of college affairs and implemented accordingly. The same procedure is applicable to the amendment of these Regulations.
