

# Regulations Governing Foreign Language Examination Registration Fee Subsidies for Students

## College of Social Sciences, National Sun Yat-Sen University

I. Aim:

These Regulations are enacted to encourage students studying in the College of Social Sciences, National Sun Yat-Sen University (hereinafter referred to as CSS) to take foreign language examinations so as to improve their foreign language proficiency and to promote international exchange student programs.

II. Source of funding:

EMPP Academic Fund of CSS

III. Application criteria:

Students studying in the undergraduate and graduate programs (not including students who are employed full-time) who have taken foreign language examinations during their studies may apply for a subsidy with the original copy of the examination transcript and qualification certificate (taken within the past two years).

IV. Application documents:

- (1) Foreign Language Examination Registration Fee Subsidy Application Form
- (2) An original copy and a photocopy of the transcript and qualification certificate (the original copy will be returned after verification)
- (3) Payment receipt (such as remittance or credit card payment details)
- (4) A photocopy of student ID

VI. Application dates:

First semester: From November 15 to November 30 yearly

Second semester: From May 15 to May 30 yearly

VII. Number of subsidies given and method by which they are granted:

**Each applicant will only receive one subsidy ever.** Please download the application form from the CSS website, fill in the form within the application period, and submit the completed form to the CSS Office for review. The list of subsidy recipients will be announced after their applications have been approved.

VIII. These regulations will be implemented upon approval by the **College Affairs Meeting**. Amendments to the regulations shall be processed accordingly.
