## College of Social Sciences Distinguished Young Scholar Award Guidelines

### Article I Purpose:

These Guidelines for the College of Social Sciences Distinguished Young Scholar Award (hereinafter, the “Award”) have been developed to encourage and reward newly appointed faculty members with potential in the College of Social Sciences who demonstrate great dedication to academic research.

### Article II Source of Funding:

Funding for the Award shall be allocated from the College of Social Sciences’ Executive Master of Public Policy (EMPP) Program academic fund.

### Article III Eligibility:

Eligibility is limited to full-time teaching faculty members of the College of Social Sciences who applied for and passed the preliminary review for the National Sun Yat-sen University (“NSYSU”) Young Scholar Award but who did not receive the award.

### Article V Payment:

Each eligible awardee shall be entitled to a one-time stipend of up to NT\$ 50,000. The stipend may only be used towards the purchase of teaching/research supplies and equipment.

### Article VI Announcement of the Award:

After the NSYSU Young Scholar Award winners are announced, a list of eligible candidates shall be compiled. Winners of the Award shall be announced following a final review by the College Academic Review Committee.

Article VII These Guidelines shall be implemented following the approval of the College General Meeting. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
